

# **Strive Adaptive Stroller Accessories**

Canopy (ST8100S, ST8100L)

# Canopy (ST8100S, ST8100L)

Extendable canopy with a clear flap-covered window. Provides protection from the rain and sunlight.

1. Snap onto the vertical pipes at the desired height (Fig 1).

# Headrest Extension (ST8112, ST8114, ST8116, ST8118)

Extends back height and support for taller individuals.

- 1. Slide the Headrest Extension posts into the pipes attached to the back of the stroller (Fig 2A).
- 2. To adjust height, adjust the position of the two round rubber washers on the headrest (Fig 2B)
- 3. To adjust tension, use the four hook and loop fastener straps on the back of the headrest (Fig 2C).

#### Padded Winged Headrest (ST8801)

Adjustable padded headrest provides comfortable midline positioning, promoting optimal posture and alignment.

- 1. Thread the cords through four grommets in the back and/or headrest extension at the desired height (*Fig 3*).
- 2. Tie the cords together in the back.

To adjust the Padded Winged Headrest's position, thread the cords through different grommets.

#### **Bus Transit Tie-Downs (ST8802)**

Secures stroller for safe transportation in a bus/van.

- 1. Take each tie-down assembly out of the box.
- 2. Remove the lock nuts and bent metal washers (keep the plastic pieces on the bolt).
- 3. Attach the tie-downs to the stroller legs (Fig 4).
- 4. Fasten with the washers and lock nuts.
- 5. Use the included wrench and small hex key to tighten every bolt.



# Basket (ST8803)

Under-seat storage basket.

- 1. Attach the basket to the stroller using all five straps as shown below (Fig 5).
- 2. Tighten straps.
- 3. Test to make sure straps will hold.

# **Anti-Tippers (ST8804)**

Prevents backward tipping and enhances stability and security.

- 1. Remove the rubber stop on the curb-assist lever (might need to hammer or pry off)
- 2. Insert the anti-tippers (make sure the locking pin locks) (Fig 6).

#### **Upper Extremity Support (ST8805)**

Depth adjustable, multi-functional clear tray is easy to clean and fits all sizes.

- 1. To assemble the tray, slide the two metal plates into the slots on the bottom (Fig 7A).
- 2. Undo the hook and loop fasteners on both side panels (for access) (Fig 7B).
- 3. Using the included wrench and medium sized hex key, partially loosen the bolt (Fig 7C).
- 4. Slide the slot of the mounting bracket around the bolt between the washer and pipe (Fig 7D).
- 5. Snap the other end of the tray mounting bracket onto the stroller frame (Fig 7E).
- 6. Repeat steps 3-5 on the other side.
- 7. Retighten the bolts.
- 8. Slide the metal rods into the mounting brackets.
- 9. Tighten the tray screw (Fig 7F).
- 10. To lock the tray in place, tighten the hand knobs on the mounting brackets.
- 11. Refasten the hook and loop fasteners on both side panels (Fig 7).

# Seat Depth Extension Kit (ST8806)

- 1. Undo the hook and loop fastener that attaches the back panel to the seat panel (Fig 8).
- 2. Relieve fabric tension by partially folding the chair.
- 3. Pull the seat panel off the seat rail in the front (both sides).
- 4. Unscrew the bolt on the side of the seat rail (Fig 8A).
- 5. Pull out the original seat tube.
- 6. Insert the Seat Depth Extension Kit seat tube.
- 7. Move new seat tube to the desired hole.
- 8. Refasten the bolt.
- 9. Repeat steps 4-8 on the other side.
- 10. Pull the seat panel back over the seat rail in the front.
- 11. Reattach the hook and loop fastener.
- 12. Fully unfold the chair.
